BMW Club Qld Sprint Series Classes and Points Calculation Details.

Classes

Our classes are kept simple, road cars are graded by engine capacity and normal or forced induction.

All road registered cars must have road legal tyres.

If non-road legal tyres are used, you move up a class.

Unregistered track cars are graded by Rear Wheel HP/Tonne.

No tyre restrictions on track cars.

Road Registered cars with factory fitted roll cages are classed as road cars

Class A/B Normally Aspirated BMW's </= 2.5 Litre Engine
Class C " " > 2.5 Litre Engine
+ E30 M3

M Class All ///M cars except E30 M3.

Class F1 All 6 cyclinder, Non ///M, BMW's with forced induction

Class F2 All 4 cyclinder, " " " " " " " "

+ Mini

Class I (Invitational) All Non-BMW's driven by members.

Class T3 All Track cars above 200 RWHP/Tonne.

Class T2 All Track cars between 151 and 200 RWHP/Tonne.

Class T3 All Track cars </=150 RWHP/Tonne.

Scoring

Points are awarded for each current financial members fastest lap, on the nominated circuit, in their class, at each event attended. Number of points awared will depend on number of people in each class on any day and your fastest lap time position in the class, with 1 (one) point per person at the time. e.g. If 5 cars in class on the day, 5 points available.

Slowest person in class gets 1 point and fastest in class gets 5 points.

Bonus points, If you win your class on the day you get an extra point. If you are the outright fastest on the day you also get an extra bonus point.

Special bonus points may be awarded for attendance at other nominated events, eg Annual Regularity Charity Challenge.
