

Rules for Happy Lap Cruising at Lakeside

HAPPY LAPS ARE **NOT** HOT LAPS or TEST LAPS

Happy Laps are for family cruising NOT performance driving, so;

Any car-to-car contact is an instant stop for the session.

Any car going off the track is an instant stop for the session >1sec

of tyre smoke is an instant stop for the session.

Enter and Exit the track ONLY by the designated areas.

In addition, during Happy Laps;

No helmets are to be worn by anybody.

No unregistered or trailered cars are permitted on the track for Happy Laps.

No Cars Fitted with after market Roll Cages. All cars must have current

registration and plates must not be obscured **Note also;**

Drivers may be breath tested—anyone reading more than 0.00 will be banned from the track.

Lakeside staff will be in attendance to ensure observance of conditions. Lakeside will name and

shame drivers who push the limits and cause a session to be cancelled.

Police have shown an interest in Happy Laps and have been invited to attend at times, at both tracks— do not be surprised to see them out on the track with you!

Tyres:

Correct tyre pressures are very important. Under-inflated tyres can, and have, peeled off rims during hard cornering.

Please have tyre pressures correctly adjusted BEFORE arrival at the program. Pressures should be raised to 40-45 PSI

There are no facilities at the venue for tyre inflation.

Before you arrive, remove all loose objects from the car and boot, check under seats as well.
